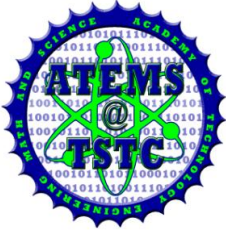

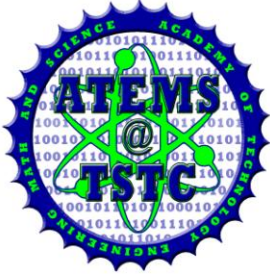
ABILENE INDEPENDENT SCHOOL DISTRICT A.T.E.M.S. STUDENT AND PARENT AGREEMENT

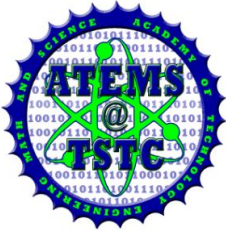

Child Nutrition Information for Free & Reduced Lunch

The Academy of Technology, Engineering, Math, & Science is an open enrollment school. We will actively recruit all students to be a part of our new school. **Our goal is to ensure that each and every interested child has an opportunity to attend ATEMS!** We will admit approximately 100 freshman students through a lottery system that ensures fairness in the selection process. The school will not select students based on ability, grades, test scores, or teacher recommendations. Families interested in having their children attend ATEMS are encouraged to apply for Free & Reduced Lunch in order to give their child a better chance to attend. If less than 100 students apply, then all qualified students will be admitted into ATEMS. If greater than 100 applications are received, preference will be given to students who qualify for the Free/Reduced lunch program. Ultimately, we want to provide a unique experience for all students in Abilene ISD. Please look closely at the table below and check if you believe your child/ren will qualify for Free or Reduced Lunch during the 2011-2012 school year.
